PROVISIONAL ORDER

DATE: 14-02-2022

1. Shree Narayana Central School, Satellite, Di: Ahmedabad- 380015, has filed its proposal for Academic Year 2021-22 for Pre- Primary & Primary Section & Secondary Section & Higher Secondary Section (Gen & Sci) (CBSE English Medium) along with relevant documents. After considering the said proposal along with the documents attached therewith, the Fee Regulatory Committee hereby determines the provisional fees for the academic year 2021-22.
2. After considering the proposal of school of dated 31.03.2021 to fixing the fees for the year: 2021-22 and other documents and perusal of the Final order of FRC dated: 29.08.2018 for the academic year: 2017-18 with 5% rise in per each year in academic year 2019-20 that is for Pre- Primary Rs. 36383/-, for Primary Rs. 38588/-, for Secondary Rs. 44100/-, for Higher Secondary (Gen) Rs. 44100/-, for Higher Secondary (Sci) Rs. 46305/-, for the academic year: 2019-20.
3. Then after committee take stands to consider covid pandemic situation from March – 20 to till the date, all the school runs online and physical school started for the secondary education approx in the month of July-2021 and all are affected by worst economic condition's So many parents lose their jobs their earning also affected and government also passed necessary resolutions on dated 07.10.2020 for the

celling limit of fees for the academic year: 2020-21 and directed to collect fees which is determined by the FRC in the A.Y: 2019-20 and also collected 75% of aforesaid of the A.Y: 2019-20. So committee comes to conclusion that their must be some balance fee structure should be decided for both parents and relevant school also. So for that some criteria taken in the consideration. By looking to the financial statement and the real condition of pandemic situation. There may be some standing expense occurred by the school in running the school online. Likewise salary of the teacher's Etc., simultaneously the parents also suffer economical loss and they also having expense for the Wi-Fi connection etc. and also even though they have paid 75% fees of A.Y: 2019-20 to the school. And parent's of above school and above school authorities passed through above situation. Hence committee determined the just and fair fee structure for the A.Y: 2021-22 on the basis of the fee structure determined by the FRC for the A.Y: 2019-20 and giving reasonable rise to the school, hence passed following provisional order for A.Y: 2021-22.

You are further directed that any excess fees charged from the students over and above the above mentioned ceiling shall have to be refunded to the students.

Terms and conditions:

1. It is directed that the School is not permitted to collect fees for any quarter of 2021-22, more than the provisional fees determined for the year 2021-22.(Subject to in future any Government Resolution passed by the Education Department regarding the declared any ceiling limit of Fee Structure due to Covid – 19 Situation.) Which is binding to the School on and above the order of the FRC.
2. It is further made clear that the school is not permitted to collect fees under any other head including under the head of Admission Fees except one month fees by

way of admission fees only in case of new admission and thereby causing no extra burden on the students.

3. Any violation of this order shall be dealt with by the Committee in accordance with law, on being brought to the notice of the Committee by any aggrieved party.
4. If the School is aggrieved by the provisional fees determined by the Committee, the school has a right to file objections before the committee within 7 days from the date of receipt of this provisional order.
5. The school is directed to place the order determining the provisional fees on its notice board as well as on the website of the school.
6. If School have no any objections on above provisional order of the A.Y : 2021-22, then treated above order as final order and as per the final order, school is permitted to collect the fees for the academic year 2022-23 and 2023-24 by giving 5% rise on the above provisional fees order. i.e. (add 5% in the A.Y : 2022-23 and on above add 5% in the A.Y : 2023-24.)
